Christ Ingathering is committed to building a global workforce of multiplying disciples with the leadership capacity for ministry on every front towards finishing the gospel task among nations.

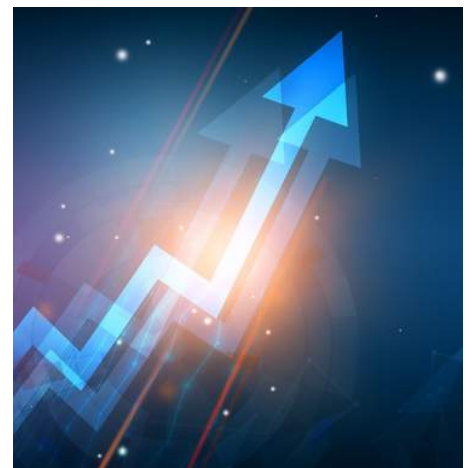
In essence, we evangelize the unreached, engage, equip and empower believers to birth self-propagating faith communities.
